## ISLE OF MAN.

The Aliens Restriction (Isle of Man) Amendment Order, 1915.

At the Court at Buckingham Palace, the 6th day of July, 1915.

PRESENT,

The King's most Excellent Majesty

Duke of Devonshire Marquess of Lansdowne Lord Chamberlain Sir Frederick Ponsonby.

Whereas His Majesty, by and with the advice of His Privy Council, has been pleased, under the provisions of the Isle of Man (War Legislation) Act, 1914, to order that the Aliens Restriction Act, 1914, shall extend to the Isle of Man:

And whereas, by the said Aliens Restriction Act, 1914, power is conferred upon His Majesty, in time of War, or Imminent National Danger, or Great Emergency, by Order in Council, to impose Restrictions on Aliens, and to make such provisions as may be necessary or expedient for carrying such Restrictions into effect:

And whereas by the Aliens Restriction (Isle of Man) Order, 1914 (hereinafter referred to as "The Principal Order"), His Majesty has been pleased to impose Restrictions on Aliens and to make various Regulations for carrying those Restrictions into

And whereas it is expedient to amend the Principal Order in

manner hereinafter appearing: Now, therefore, His Majesty is pleased, by and with the advice of His Privy Council, to order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows :-

1.--(1) After the 15th day of July, 1915, it shall be the duty of the Keeper of every Hotel, Inn, Boarding-house and Lodginghouse, to ascertain and enter in a Register kept for the purpose the names and nationality of all persons over the age of 14 years staying at the Hotel, Inn, Boarding-house, or Lodging-house, who are Aliens, together with the dates of their arrival and departure, their destinations on departure, and such other particulars as may be prescribed by the Lieutenant-Governor, and if the Keeper of an Hotel, Inn, Boarding-house, or Lodging-house, fails to do so, or if he makes any entry in any such Register-
